# The Power & Purpose of Baptism from a Scriptural Point of View Part 2

#### Scriptural Baptism, Proclaimed, Preached, Passed On & Powered by the Spirit!

- Proclaimed by the Authority of the Lord in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20)
- Preached by Jesus to Nicodemus(John 3:1-7)
- Passed on to Peter from Jesus, "the keys to the kingdom" (Matthew 16:19).
- Preached by Peter at Pentecost (Acts 2:36-41).
- Powered by the Spirit; the active agent in baptism? (1 Corinthians 12:13).

## **Baptism: Proclaimed Authority**

 "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:18-20, NIV).

# **Baptism: Proclaimed Authority**

- "I will build my church" (Matthew 16:18, NIV)
- Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:31-32, NIV).

# **Baptism: Preached By Jesus**

- Jesus said to Nicodemus, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again." (John 3:3, NIV).
- Jesus said, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit." (John 3:6, NIV).

#### **Baptism: Passed on to Peter**

 Jesus said to Peter, "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." (Matthew 16:19).

## **Baptism: Preached By Peter**

 "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (Acts 2:38, NIV).

- For we were all baptized by one Spirit into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. (1 Corinthians 12:13, NIV)
- The Spirit of God is the ACTIVE AGENT IN
  BAPTISM!
- ARE YOU OR HAVE YOU BEEN POSITIONED TO RECEIVE THE BLESSINGS OF CHRIST?

 You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. (Galatians 3:26-27, NIV)

 In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will, 12 in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. 13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, 14 who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory. (Ephesians 1:11-14, NIV).

 ...this water symbolizes baptism that now saves you also—not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a good conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ,... (1 Peter 3:21, NIV)
