Read 1 John 2:1-6; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.

According to these verses why did the Eternal Son of God become a man?

How do you tend to divide your life in this way? What aspects of your life do you tend to keep for yourself, as opposed to submitting them to Him? Why?

Read 1 John 2:6 once again. Read also John 10:10; 15:1-4

What is the relationship between "walking as Jesus walked" and experiencing life "wide awake" in Him? How does this shape your understanding of obedience to God?
