ekklesia (Church) actually means: an assembly or gathering.

1.A <u>SIMPLE</u> MESSAGE. 2. AN <u>Expanding</u> Mission. 3. A <u>Serious</u> devotion.

• **Devoted means**: To be earnest towards, to persevere, be constantly diligent, or to attend tirelessly all the exercises.

Acts 2:42-47 They <u>devoted themselves</u> to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³ Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. ⁴⁴ All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ <u>Selling their</u> <u>possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need</u>. ⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together <u>with glad and sincere hearts</u>, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.
