Acts 2:42-47 - They <u>devoted themselves</u> to the <u>apostles' teaching</u> and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³ Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. ⁴⁴ All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. ⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. THREE MARKS OF A DISCIPLE:

Matthew 4:19-20 - "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men." ²⁰ At once they left their nets and followed him.

Matthew 4:19 - "Come, follow me," Jesus said, ...

FOLLOW MEANS: THE SAME WAY WITH.

John 12:26 - Whoever <u>serves me</u> must <u>follow me</u>; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honor the one who serves me.

- KNOWLEDGE WITHOUT OBEDIENCE LEADS TO PRIDE.
- **1 Corinthians 8:1-2 -** Now about food sacrificed to idols: We know that we all possess knowledge. **Knowledge puffs up, but love builds up**. ² The man who thinks he knows something does not yet know as he ought to know.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore <u>encourage</u> one another and <u>build each other</u> <u>up</u>, just as in fact you are doing.
 - Encourage means: To call near, invite, invoke.
 - Build up means: To be a house-builder, construct, confirm.

The process of transformation or what we would call sanctification.

"will make" means: to render or "make" one or oneself anything, or cause a person or thing to become something.

Romans 8:29 -For those God foreknew he also predestined to be **conformed to the likeness of his Son**,...

• HE TRANSFORMS HOW WE SEE THE WORLD, WHAT WE VALUE, AND WHAT WE CONSIDER TO BE IMPORTANT.

Romans 12:2 - Do not **conform** any longer to the pattern of this world, but be **transformed** by the renewing of your mind.

2 Corinthians 3:17-18 - Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. ¹⁸ And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being **transformed into his likeness** with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

2 Corinthians 5:15-20 - And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again. 17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! 18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. 20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

• WHEN A DISCIPLE'S HEART IS TRANSFORMED, IT MOVES US INTO ACTION.

Ephesians 2:10 - For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

A GROWING DISCIPLE OF CHRIST IS A PERSON WHO IS FOLLOWING CHRIST (HEAD), IS BEING TRANSFORMED (HEART), WHICH LEADS TO A COMMITMENT TO THE MISSION OF CHRIST (HANDS).
