Galatians 5:13-14 - You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love. ¹⁴The entire law is summed up in a single command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

Galatians 5:1 - It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a **yoke of slavery**.

Galatians 5:13 - You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature...

3. No one is truly free until they know
Galatians 5:16-17 - So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. ¹⁷ For the sinful nature <u>desires</u> what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, <u>so that you do not do what you want.</u>
4. This is why self-effort to change will work. It can't. Galatians 5:16 - So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature.
5. Here is where we all struggle: We think if I fulfill the lust of the flesh, then I'll be walking in the Spirit.
6. Holiness <i>is not the</i> way <i>to</i> Christ <i>;</i> Christ is the way to holiness.
➢ How to a Spirit-controlled life. Galatians 5:18 - But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under law.
1. Led means: To be led of the Spirit. Galatians 5:16 - So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature.
2. Live means: To tread all around, i.e. walk at large (especially as proof of ability); figuratively, to live, deport oneself, follow (as a companion or votary):
