- Often we enter into a dangerous place and we know it by cones, fences and signs.
- The longer we live in the danger zone of self-deception, the more difficult it becomes to <u>see</u> the danger (Denial). We believe that it will not <u>harm</u> us (Doubt), and the more convinced we are that we are <u>right</u> (Deception).
- Things are really dangerous when we <u>don't know</u> or acknowledge that we are in a danger zone.

**Genesis 1:26**. Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, in our likeness, and let them <u>rule</u>...

elders of the Jews to him, asking him to come and heal his servant. <sup>4</sup> When they came to Jesus, they pleaded earnestly with him, "This man deserves to have you do this, <sup>5</sup> because he loves our nation and has built our synagogue." <sup>6</sup> So Jesus went with them. He was not far from the house when the centurion sent friends to say to him: "Lord, don't trouble yourself, for I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. <sup>7</sup> That is why I did not even consider myself worthy to come to you. But say the word, and my servant will be healed. <sup>8</sup> For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." <sup>9</sup> When Jesus heard this, he was <u>amazed at him</u>, and turning to the crowd following him, he said, "I tell you, I have not found such great faith even in Israel."
