## "GOD'S WRITTEN WORD" (The Old Testament)

How can we come to know and experience in living reality the one true and living God; and continue to experience Him every day of our lives?

The answer is: His Written Word. (The Bible)

God is alive and present through every copy of His Written Word!

- I. <u>There is a theological correlation</u> between the <u>Eternal Word of God</u>, <u>the Living Word of God</u> in human flesh, and <u>God's Holy Written Word</u>.
  - A. The Word of God was <u>God's active agent</u> in creating the Universe. (Genesis 1)
  - B. In the Gospel of John we learn that the Word of God was the Person of God that existed in eternity as the Son of God.

    John 1:1-3: vs. 14:
    - 1. This Eternal "Word" is the Person of Jesus Christ.
  - 2. The Living Word and the Eternal Word of God are  $\underline{one\ in}$  the same; Jesus.
    - C. The Eternal Word and the Living Word are revealed to us by means of the *Written Word of God*.

II. Let us <u>first look at the Old Testament</u> for <u>several examples</u> of how we can come to know God and experience Him personally.

- A. The Names of God revealed from the Old Testament.
  - 1. The <u>Hebrew name of God</u> Exodus 3. <u>"I AM!"</u> (Yahweh)
  - 2. Other titles of God found in the Old Testament:

Jireh - "God is my Provider" (Genesis 22:14)

Rophe - "God is my Healer" (Exodus 15:26)

Nissi - "God is my Banner" (Exodus 17:15)

M'Kiddish - "God is my Sanctification (Leviticus 20:8)

Shalom - "God is my Peace" (Judges 6:24)

Rohi - "God is my Shepherd" (Psalm 23:1)

Tsidkenu - "God is my Righteousness" (Jeremiah 23:6)

Shammah - "God is Present with me" (Ezekiel 48:35)
