Private/corporate worship, is there a difference?

- “Me too we”
- Worship is for God. We should find out what He wants.

A call to orderly worship:

1. Tongues

- Two or three at the most.
- One at a time.
- Interpretation is a must.
- No interpreter? Be quiet.

2. Prophecy

- Two or three at the most.
- Weigh carefully what’s said.
- Needs to be done in order.
- Should instruct and encourage.
- Willing to submit to God’s instructions.
- Does not bring confusion.

3. Women

- Are to keep silent (What does that mean?).
 - The church is for Jesus!
- Should be in submission (What does that mean?).
- Should submit to their husband’s leadership (What does that look like?).
- Who are we trying to please? God?
 - Did God’s Word originate with you?
 - Did you write the Bible?
 - Are we the only ones it’s reached?
 - The Lord doesn’t give suggestions He gives commands.
 - If you won’t listen to Scripture we won’t listen to you.
