3. Petition for Needs
4. Forgive Sins
5. Deliver from Evil

1. Kingdom
2. Power
3. Glory

1. THE WORSHIP & PRAISE OF GOD
2. OUR BRINGING THE REALITY OF GOD'S
KINGDOM INTO THE EARTH REALM



UNDERSTANDING THE KINGDOM OF GOD

1. The Kingdom of God is the place where God will rule and reign
2. Kingdom of God is righteousness, peace and joy (James 3:17; Romans 14:17)
3. The Kingdom of God comes not in word (talk) only, but in power. (1 Cor 4:20; 1 Thess. 1:5)
 - Power to heal, deliver, transform
 - Power to overcome the enemy
 - Power to live a life pleasing to God
 - Power to overcome all the strategies of the enemy

Kingdom Come...

Aorist, Active, Imperative Verb Tenses

1. **Aorist:** “The aorist verb tense is used by the writer to present the action of a verb as a “snapshot” event. The verb’s action is portrayed simply and in summary fashion without respect to any process. An aorist participle usually refers to antecedent time with respect to the main verb.”
2. **Active:** Continuous Action
3. **Imperative:** Command that is expressing a state of possibility

THE TIMING OF THE KINGDOM

1. WHEN? NOW!

- a. **Matthew 6:10 ... your kingdom come**
 - a. No Delays in the Kingdom!
 - b. *Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread*
 - c. *Matthew 7:7 Ask and it will be given*
- b. Jesus said for us to pray that the Kingdom of God is a NOW Reality in our life



THE LOCATION OF THE KINGDOM

2. WHERE? HERE!

- a) **Luke 17:20-21** "The kingdom of God does not come with your careful observation, ²¹ nor will people say, 'Here it is,' or 'There it is,' **because the kingdom of God is within you.**"
- b) If the King is in the hearts of individuals, churches, cities and nations, **THERE** will be the Kingdom.
- c) Kingdom is a tangible visible reality only after our New Birth (John 3:3)
