


Passover,

THE LORD'S PASSOVER

- 1. On 10th day select an unblemished lamb (Jesus entered Jerusalem on this day)
- 2. Examine the lamb for 5 days, i.e. days 10-14 (Jesus was examined by the Romans and the Jews days 10-14)
- 3. On day 14, bring the lamb to the threshold of the home and slay the (Jesus was crucified on this same day at the very hour the lambs of Passover were killed)
- 4. Collect the blood in a basin and apply the blood to the doorposts to protect (Blood of Jesus applied to those who believe. Salvation only through the Blood of Jesus)




1 Corinthians 5:7

#1: RESTORED 'NEW LIFE' IN CHRIST

Beginning of Months

- Exodus 12:2 (NLT) "From now on, this month will be the first month of the year for you.
- Jesus Makes Us A New Creation (II Cor. 5:17;
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT) This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!



#2. RESTORED RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD Set Apart from His Wrath of the Final Plague

- Set Apart as a People of Purpose (Gen 1:28)
 - Destined for Land Flowing With Milk & Honey (Ex.3:8)
 - Destined to Serve and Worship God (Ex. 5:1; 7:16)
- Jesus Set Us Apart As His Church (Mt. 16:18)
 - Members of His Body (I Cor 3:9; I Cor 12)
 - Restored Purpose and Destiny (Eph 2:10; 3:10)
 - Delivered us from Wrath (I Thess. 1:10; Gal 3:13; Romans 5:9-10)



#3. RESTORED MANIFEST PRESENCE OF GOD

- Manifest Presence of God With Them
 Continually (Exodus 13:21-22)
- Jesus Brought to Us the Presence of God
 - Jesus Revealed the Father (John 14:9)
 - The Holy Spirit Sent (John 16:7; Acts 2:33)
 - We Are the Dwelling Place of God (I Cor. 3:16)



#4. RESTORED IDENTITY

Reunited with your God-purpose and destiny

- Egypt's (Satan's) Lie:
 - From a Greatness to Slaves
 - From a Destiny to Oppression
 - From Wealth to Poverty
 - From Acceptance to Self-Rejection
- God Reclaimed His People (Exodus 3:8)
- Jesus Restores Our Identity as Children of God
 - Firstborn of many brethren (Romans 8:29)
 - Made us to be kings and priests (Rev. 1:6)



#5. RESTORED FREEDOM: NO LONGER SLAVES

- Enemy Destroyed (Exodus 14:14, 27-31)
- The Dignity of Choice Returned (Deut 30:19-20)
- Jesus Destroyed Work of Satan in Our
 Life (I Jn 3:8; Col 2:15; Luke 10:19; Rom
 8:31-39; Mark 16:18; Luke 4:18-20)



REMEMBERING PASSOVER THROUGH COMMUNION

Luke 22:14-20 (ESV) — 14 And when the hour came, he reclined at table, and the apostles with him. 15 And he said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. 16 For I tell you I will not eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God." 17 And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he said, "Take this, and divide it among yourselves. 18 For I tell you that from now on I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes." 19 And he took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." 20 And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood.
