Having Confidence In Difficult Times

- 1. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death
- When you're walking with the shepherd, the dark valley always <u>leads to higher</u> <u>ground.</u>

Three things to remember about the shadows

- a. Shadows are always bigger than the reality
- b. Shadows <u>cannot hurt you</u>
- c. There is no shadow without *light somewhere*
- 2. I will fear no evil, for you are with me
- The secret to getting through the valley is Get *personal* in your *relationship* with God.
- 3. Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
