Holding On While Balancing Truth and Tolerance

Options:

- A. Truth without tolerance is **legalism**
- B. Tolerance without truth is *liberalism*
- C. Truth with tolerance is **balance**
- John 1:14 (ESV)
- John 1:17 (ESV)

How to Balance the Two:

1. Is this a major or minor issue according to the Bible?

Principle: In maJor issues have unity. In minor issues have diversity. In all issues show love.

- 2. Do you have a **biblical** conviction about the issue?
- Romans 14:5 (ESV)
- Romans 14:14 (ESV)
- Romans 14:22 (ESV)

Principle: If it's **doubtful**, don't do it

- 3. How will your decision/involvement impact an *immature* believer?
- Romans 14:13 (ESV)
- Romans 14:19 (ESV)

Principle: I have a <u>responsibility</u> to others

4. Will this <u>reflect my love</u> for the Lord?

Principle: I must remember <u>whose I am</u>, then consider if an activity or attitude will demonstrate my love for Jesus

5. What would my **spiritual** role model do?

Principle: Spend time with <u>mature</u> believers
