## Experiencing God: Will I Believe When God Speaks? Dr. Sam Crouch March 15, 2020

1. An encounter with God requires faith.

**Hebrews 11:1 (NLT)** – "Faith is the confidence that what we hope for will actually happen; it gives us assurance about things we cannot see."

**Romans 4:20-21 (NLT)** – "Abraham never wavered in believing God's promise. In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God. <sup>21</sup> He was fully convinced that God is able to do whatever he promises."

**2 Corinthians 5:7 (NIV)** – *"We live by faith, not by sight."* 

**Mark 10:27 (NLT)** – "Jesus looked at them intently and said, 'Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But not with God. Everything is possible with God."

**Hebrews 11:6 (NLT)** – "And it is impossible to please God without faith."

2. An encounter with God is God-sized.

Matthew 14:15-16 (NLT) – "This is a remote place, and it's already getting late. Send the crowds away so they can go to the villages and buy food for themselves. <sup>16</sup> But Jesus said, 'That isn't necessary—you feed them."

## **3. Our reaction to encountering God, reveals** what we believe about God.

James 2:14, 26 (NLT) – "What good is it, dear brothers and sisters, if you say you have faith but don't show it by your actions? Can that kind of faith save anyone? <sup>26</sup> Just as the body is dead without breath, so also faith is dead without good works." **1 Samuel 17:45-47 (NLT)** – "David replied to the Philistine, 'You come to me with sword, spear, and javelin, but I come to you in the name of the LORD of Heaven's Armies—the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. <sup>46</sup> Today the LORD will conquer you, and I will kill you and cut off your head. And then I will give the dead bodies of your men to the birds and wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel! <sup>47</sup> And everyone assembled here will know that the LORD rescues his people, but not with sword and spear. This is the LORD's battle, and he will give you to us!"

**Genesis 16:2 (NLT)** – "So Sarai said to Abram, 'The LORD has prevented me from having children. Go and sleep with my servant. Perhaps I can have children through her."
